

PB	In Prep B we are off to a very busy start making new friends and learning new routines. We are learning rhyming words and counting syllables. We have also read storybooks to build our oral language and comprehension skills.
PC	In PC we have been settling into school life! We have been learning about words and how a group of words can make a sentence. We have been exploring the playground and describing what plants and insects need to survive. We have also set ourselves physical 'Goals' which we practice three times a week!
PK	Prep K have started the year on the right foot getting set into our new routines and learning what it is like to be at school.
